I understand that during the period of the residential event named above my child will be in the charge of the leaders present and under their instructions. I do, however accept that my child may be returned home if, in the opinion of the leaders in charge, he or she has behaved in a way, which is unacceptable under normal circumstances.

During the course of this event your child may be photographed or recorded on video. On the occasion that this material is used for promotional purposes within the Youth Development Group, by signing this form, you consent to your child's image(s) being used for this purpose.

Natural fathers who are not married to the child's mother may obtain parental responsibility by either a Court Order, a Formal Agreement lodged at court, or a residence order.
